Onsite residential accommodation is available for young people wishing to study with us.

The college's purpose-built residential accommodation provides a home from home environment with lounge areas, a relaxation room, ensuite bedrooms, fully accessible bathrooms, a laundry service and adjustable kitchens.

# Meeting new friends and gaining confidence

**Young people who choose to stay at Hereward on a residential basis develop independence and life skills, make new friends, gain confidence and take more control over their own care with the support of our experienced staff.**

A holistic package of support includes nursing, speech and language therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, assistive technology specialists and clinical psychologists.

- Planning and budgeting for meals
