ILS Pathway (Teaching Assistant)

We have an exciting opportunity for teaching support assistants to join our team. Ideally the successful candidates will have a broad knowledge base of working with learners with special educational needs and disabilities or will have a keen interest in working in this highly satisfying area of work.

In your role as a member of the Individual Learning Support staff team you will be responsible for supporting students in an educational environment under the guidance of the teaching staff. You will be involved in the monitoring and recording of students' progress through effective target setting and ensuring that students are able to access the curriculum effectively. You may also be responsible for delivering aspects of personal care to individual students.

To apply, you should have level 2 numeracy and literacy, or be able to demonstrate via an assessment that you are operating at level 2 in both subjects. You should have experience of working in a flexible and responsive team as well working in a learning environment. You will need to be a team worker, with good communication skills. You should have good IT skills with the ability to lead others. It is important to have a positive, proactive, flexible approach to work and a strong commitment to student success.

ILS Residential / Classroom Support

In your role as ILS Residential / Classroom Support, you will be responsible for supporting students in the residential provision where you will enable students to achieve their independence targets. You will be responsible for monitoring and assessing students' progress through effective target setting and ensuring that students are able to access the curriculum effectively. You will also be responsible for delivering all aspects of personal care to individual students, and take responsibility for the raising of student's individual care plans and risk assessments.

To apply, you should possess an NVQ Level 2 in Care and a Level 2 qualification in safe handling of medication (or achieved within 6 months). You will have a level 2 qualification in numeracy and literacy. If you do not hold Level 2 or equivalent qualification in Maths and English, you will be required to undergo an assessment to determine you are operating at the required level. You should have experience of working in a flexible and responsive team as well as experience of working in a care environment. You will need to be a team worker, with good communication skills. You should have good IT skills and the ability to prioritise workloads. It is important to have a positive, proactive, flexible approach to work and a strong commitment to student success.
