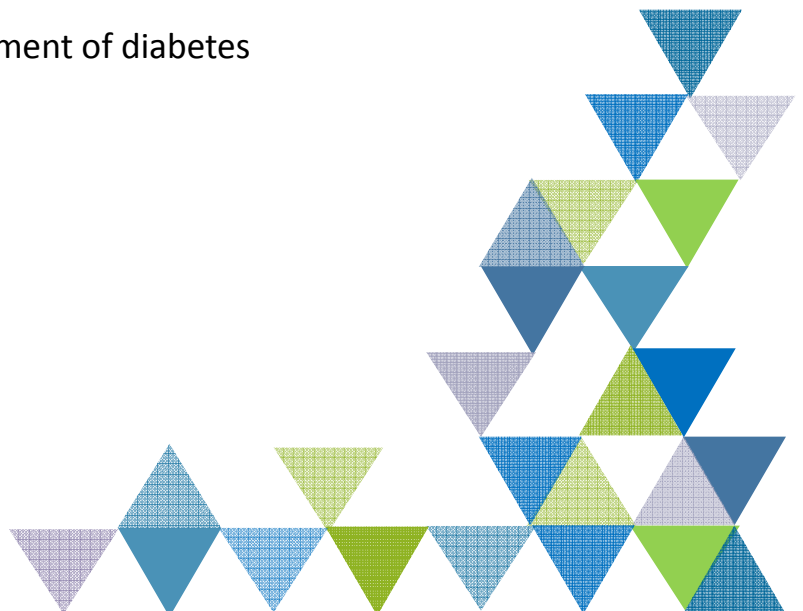
What are the benefits of doing this course?

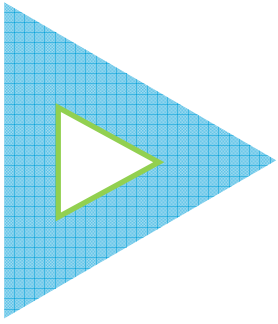
This course will help learners apply good practice related to care and management of diabetes, giving them confidence in their work. As diabetes is an ongoing and increasing problem, learners will acquire practical understanding that will be useful throughout their working and personal lives.

Course content

The Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Care and Management of Diabetes comprises four units across two module workbooks as follows:

- ▶ Understand diabetes
- ▶ Prevention and early intervention of Type 2 diabetes
- ▶ Understand the initial care of diabetes
- ▶ Understand the treatment and management of diabetes





Progression opportunities

By undertaking this programme, candidates will be able to further their own continuous professional development, which may improve their career prospects.

Course delivery and assessment

The programme enables learners to complete the course in their own time, and all study material and resources are provided. Learners have access to a tutor and the programme is marked based on modular assessment. There is also the opportunity to work through a series of reflective activities designed to reinforce the learning.

Entry requirements

Learners should be aged 16 and over but otherwise there are no specific entry requirements for this programme.
